The Moraine Valley Police Department offers many services, which include:

- Emergency first aid for the ill or injured
- Motorized, foot, and bicycle patrol on campus
- Access and control to college buildings
- Disaster control procedures in response to fire, tornado, or other related emergency conditions
- Enforcement of college traffic rules and regulations, and other college rules
- Traffic accident investigations
- Escort service on campus
- Programs on accident prevention, crime prevention and safety and security
- Investigations into criminal offenses or related incidents
- Identification and correction of safety hazards on campus
- Assistance to motorists in emergencies
- Emergency message notification
- Processing and cataloging lost and found items
- Regular inspection of life safety equipment and supplies
- Records and maintains data for the Jeanne Clery Act
